The Home School Agreement is an informal contract between school, parents and the children. We ask that you read it carefully so that you can help your child to understand it, to get the most out of their time at Pickering Infants and we encourage you to become involved in the life of the school.

We agree to

- fulfil the aims of the school
- implement and review the school's policies and guidelines
- promote positive attitudes to learning
- provide termly progress targets and a written annual report
- provide opportunities to meet with the staff to discuss progress
- lend books for reading at home
- discuss any potential difficulties at school
- provide a weekly newsletter
- provide information about education, welfare and sources of advice
- provide home learning guidelines

We need you to agree to

- support the aims of the school as stated in our prospectus
- support the school's policy and guidelines
- support and work with the school to develop a positive attitude to learning by your child
- ensure that your child arrives at school on time and properly equipped
- avoid your child from missing school for reasons other than illness or in very exceptional circumstances
- ensure your child has plenty of sleep in term time and is well enough to have a full day in school
- support your child in home learning
- attend meetings to discuss your child's progress
- let the school know if you have a concern about your child including anything likely to affect your child's learning

- Do be gentle
- Do be honest
- Do be kind and helpful
- Do listen to people
- Do look after property
- Do work hard
