- ☐ **Birthday Assemblies**—These are held monthly with parents being invited to celebrate their child’s birthday in school—times vary
- ☐ **Parents’ Evenings**—Sign up sheets are in the school cloakrooms for parents to sign up to see their child’s class teacher - Nursery →Y2
- ☐ **Poppies**—Poppies will be on sale in school from the 6th to 10th November. Please send any donations with your child for them to purchase a poppy in class during the day
- ☐ **Safety Week**—Children across school are involved in learning about keeping themselves safe. Look out for useful information and web links being sent by email at the end of the week
- ☐ **After School Clubs**—Clubs are open to Year 1 and 2 children—separate letters with times and dates will be sent out at the beginning of the new half term
- ☐ **National Anti Bullying Week**—Children will be learning the difference between actions , which are children learning to work and play together well, who sometimes get that wrong, and repeated, targeted behaviour which is classed as bullying
- ☐ **Children in Need** - Children to bring their teddy bear to school for teddy bear picnic. Staff bake buns/small cakes for the children to have at teddy bear picnic . Donations will be collected but all the children will receive a baked treat. Children are invited to join staff in wearing spots on this day—anything from a headband, a full outfit or a few spots their face/school jumper
- ☐ **Non-uniform day**—Children and staff come to school in ‘non-uniform’ clothes in exchange for a gift or prize for the Christmas fair
- ☐ **School Christmas Fair**—This is an annual event run by the Home School Association (HSA). Full details will be on the school newsletter nearer the date asking for volunteers etc.
- ☐ **Writing Week**—During this week children are set their new writing targets in Rec/Y1/Y2 that they will focus on developing over the week. Children will bring their targets home at the end of the week to share with parents
- ☐ **Christmas Post Box**—Opening times Monday 11th December to 15th December - this is to enable your child/children to post cards to their friends in school. *Parent volunteers will be needed to sort cards—sign up sheet will be put outside the office nearer the date*
- ☐ **Children’s Christmas Lunch**—Mrs Haworth, Mrs Boyes and Mrs Ring (our school cooks) prepare a seasonal meal for the children—packed lunch children are also invited. All children sit down, with their crackers, all together
- ☐ **Christmas Productions**—Entrance to the performances are by ticket only—a separate letter will be sent out mid November with times of the performances with a request slip for parents to complete for their allocation of tickets
- ☐ **Town Carol Service**—This is a town event to which everyone are invited—some of our Y2 children take part in the service and will bring a letter home with details of this nearer the time
- ☐ **School Church Service**—This involves the whole school attending a Church Service at Pickering Parish Church—all welcome
- ☐ **Christmas Jumper Day**—Dust off the Christmas jumper or use tinsel/Christmas decorations to decorate school jumpers. Donations for Save the Children.
