Attendance

Good attendance and punctuality are important to a child's success in all aspects of school life. It has an impact on progress and achievement as well as friendships. Thank you to all of those parents who ensure that they arrive at school on time every day – it is always trickier on cold, wet mornings but almost all of our children arrive on time, prepared to learn, every day!

A quick checklist of reminders:

- 🔔 Telephone school on the first day of your child's absence
- 🔔 Ensure that your contact details are up to date in case we need to contact you in an emergency or for information
- 🔔 Be firm with your child about their attendance
- 🔔 Try to arrange appointments out of school time
- 🔔 If problems persist then do not hesitate to contact us to discuss them

Lateness

Arriving late to school may cause difficulties for your child

- ☹ Missing important information about the day in registration
- ☹ It may be embarrassing to walk into a lesson that has already

started

- ☹ Missing even part of a lesson can be difficult to catch up on
- ☹ It can affect behaviour and self-esteem

If your child is late or going to be late:

- ☹ Contact us and let us know why
- ☹ Take your child to their classroom and then sign the late book afterwards
- ☹ Come and see us if you have any difficulties

Lateness and absence is checked weekly by the Headteacher

Your support for your child's education is crucial to their progress. Please let us know if there is any adjustments we need to make to help you support your child, for example: letters in large font; letters in different languages; wheelchair access; explaining things over the phone.
