A Message from the Chair of Governors

Hello everyone, while it may only feel like a few weeks since Mrs Gillam went on maternity leave, we have been busy planning the leadership structure for when she returns. I am very pleased to say Mrs Gillam will be back in school as Head Teacher after the October half term break. Initially this will be on a part-time basis until Christmas with the Head's role shared between Mrs Gillam and Mr Newton, Mrs Gillam will then be back full-time from December 17th. Mr Palmer will return to the Junior School on a full time basis from October half term before moving on to his headship in January.

I would also like to inform you that Mr Newton has accepted a secondment opportunity working with both Huntington Research School in York and York City Council. This will initially be for 2 days a week in November and December before becoming a full-time secondment in January 2019 for a 12-month period. Mr Newton will then return to our school in December 2019.

The governors are conscious that changes to the leadership structure may cause a period of uncertainty for pupils, parents and staff. We are, however, delighted that we have been able to secure a structure that enables Mrs Gillam to have a phased return to school and allows Mr Newton to pursue an exciting opportunity outside of the Infant school.

<u>Threadworms</u>

We have had one or two parents who have reported to us that their child has had threadworms. There is no need to exclude a pupil from school whilst having the treatment, Thorough handwashing is always encouraged in school encouraged in sch9ool after using the toilet and before having food.

Head lice/Nits



Head lice are an ongoing pest in schools across the country and outs is no exception. Please be vigilant, checking your child's hair daily and treating when necessary. You will have to keep checking to make sure that all the eggs have gone even after treatment. Contact the doctors' surgery or the pharmacy for further information.

Your support for your child's education is crucial to their progress. Please let us know if there is any adjustments we need to make to help you support your child, for example: letters in large font; letters in different languages; wheelchair access; explaining things over the phone.
