- Birthday Assemblies—These are held monthly with parents being invited to celebrate their child's birthday in school—times vary
- Poppies—Poppies will be on sale in school from the 5th to 9th November. Please send any donations with your child for them to purchase a poppy in class during the day
- Safety Week—Children across school are involved in learning about keeping themselves safe. Look out for useful information and web links being sent by email at the end of the week
- Friendship and Anti Bullying Week—Children will be learning the difference between actions, which are children learning to work and play together well, who sometimes get that wrong, and repeated, targeted behaviour which is classed as bullying

Children are invited to join staff in wearing spots on this day—anything from a headband, a full outfit or a few spots their face/school jumper

- School Christmas Fair—This is an annual event run by the Friends of Pickering Infant School (FOS).
