We talk to our children regularly

about the importance of drinking water. In class, children are asked to have a drink at the start of each session and are free to access their water bottles during learning time where they are not sat on the carpet together. Children are all given a cup of water with their lunch, which they are asked to finish. Water bottles are also taken outside on warm days. Any children who forget their water bottle, have access to cups and water in the hall. Staff feel that they give lots of

encouragement to children to drink water throughout the day. This was something raised by a parent with Ofsted in our most recent inspection. If there is anything that any parents feels that we could do that we are not already doing then we would always welcome your suggestions.
