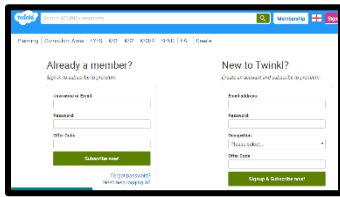

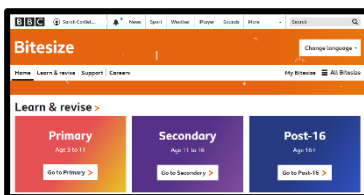

your little ones would like to keep in touch with Biff, Chip & Kipper!



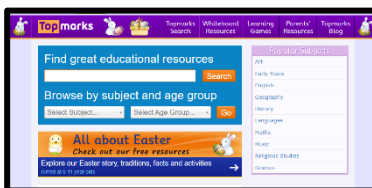
