

Pickering Community Infant and Nursery School Behaviour Policy
Addendum – Covid-19 September 2020

Approved by the Full Governing Body August 2020

Our current Behaviour Policy is based on meeting the needs of all children in school and to help them understand how to keep themselves and others happy and safe.

In the current circumstances, there are now behaviours that previously would have been acceptable and reasonable behaviours that are now no longer allowed. These continue to fit within our Golden Rules but staff will spend time regularly going over a list of key rules and routines within this, including;

Social distancing of 2 metres, where possible

Regular hand washing

Not sharing resources, wherever possible

In line with our use of common language for consistency for the children, staff will explain actions that are no longer in line with our expectations of behaviour using explanation, 'We need to keep everyone as safe as we can so we are not doing xxx at the moment' We will continue to give clear explanations of what the child has done that is now unacceptable and explain this in a way that doesn't frighten or worry the children.
