Transition

During this half term we start preparing our children for their move to their class for September. There is a letter detailing the class structure September and class lists, detailing the first names of all children in the class along with class name and class teacher name will be shared on 2nd July. Along with this, we will be sharing a video from your child's class teacher (s), a presentation of inside school, a photo book showing staff and key areas, such as toilets and coat pegs for child's classroom and vour presentation for parents about your child's new year group. We will be holding a session on 7th July for children to spend time with their new class teacher. We are unfortunately, unable to host a face to face meeting for parents at this time.

Parking

A quick reminder for all parents that the staff car park in front of school is for staff only and must not be used by parents to drop off or collect their children from school. There is strictly no stopping or parking in the bus lanes and parking tickets for offenders can be issued by parking wardens. It is essential these are clear at the start and end of the school day. We know that parking on the streets around school can be difficult but please remember that we have the parking permit system in place to help with this. For a charge of £5, an annual permit can be purchased for Eastgate car park for parking until 9.15am and between 3.15pm and 3.30pm durina term time. Please contact the school office if you would like to purchase a permit for the new academic year.

Trespassing

Absences during Term Time

We appreciate how valuable family time is and the difficulties that Covid has caused on many levels. Whilst we understand and both share the disappointment of families not being able to take their planned holidays this year, we also know that the children have had a lot of disruption and change. I therefore urge families not to book holidays during term time and give children the opportunity to settle into routines and back to build relationships with their peers and their staff team. Headteachers are only able grant leave of absence exceptional circumstances. The law, which came into force 1st on September 2013, also states that parents have no entitlement to take their child on holiday in term time.

All requests for absences from school must be applied for by completing a 'Leave of Absence' form which is available on the website or from the school office. Family holidays do not fall into the category of exceptional circumstances.

Operation Encompass

Operation Encompass is a County wide scheme that has been designed to provide early reporting to schools of any domestic abuse incidents that occur outside of normal school hours and that might have had an impact on a child attending our school. This information will be shared at the earliest opportunity Mon to Thurs and, when an incident occurs on a Fri, Sat or Sun, the police will contact us the following week.

This is for information only for staff to be able to support children appropriately in school, if necessary. Information is shared confidentially with school. Police will share this information where it is identified that a child or young person was present, witnessed or was involved in a domestic abuse incident.

As always though, if parents have concerns about the safety or welfare of any child, Children's Social Care can be contacted through the NYCC switchboard on 01609 780780. Any immediate concerns that a child is at risk of immediate harm must be reported to the police.

Your support for your child's education is crucial to their progress. Please let us know if there is any adjustments we need to make to help you support your child, for example: letters in large font; letters in different languages; wheelchair access; explaining things over the phone.
