Reading

As part of our drive on reading, please find attached a flyer for Pickering Book Tree. We are delighted that they have launched a scheme that will provide a great deal of support to the schools in Pickering. For every £10.00 that is spent at Pickering Book Tree between Saturday 26th November and Saturday 17th December, they will donate £1.00 towards reading books for our school, Pickering Juniors or St. Joseph's school. At the end of each purchase, customers will be given a marble to place into the jar of the school of their choice (with an additional jar for non-preference). Once the donation period has ended, we will be able to put these donations towards purchasing a list of new titles based on suggestions from the children and staff. This is a fantastic scheme so please support it if you are able to. Thank you. You can support your child in reading in a variety of ways, listening to them read their school book, learning rhymes and poems, reading and sharing bedtime stories together, reading signs in the environment. Reading is a vital life long skill, gaining positive experiences at this stage is so important for a life long love of reading. We encourage parents to share stories and texts daily and to support your child reading at least 3-4 times a week. A child will need to read a book around 4 times. Twice to work out the words. once for accuracy and fluency and once for discussion.

may be available from the office once all requests have been allocated.




