Operation Encompass

Operation Encompass is a Countywide scheme designed to provide early reporting to schools of any domestic abuse incidents that occur outside of normal school hours and that might have an impact on a child attending our school. This information will be shared at the earliest opportunity. This is for information for staff to be able to support children in school, if necessary. Information is shared confidentially with school. Police will share this

information where it is identified that a child was present, witnessed or was involved in a domestic abuse incident.

As always though, if parents have concerns about the safety or welfare of any child, Children's Social Care can be contacted through the NYCC switchboard on **0300 131 2 131**. Any immediate concerns that a child is at risk of harm must be reported to the police.

Parking

Over the past few months we have seen a rise in traffic and parking issues across Ruffa Lane at drop off and collection times which can pose an issue for the safety of those walking on the paths and around school. I would like to take this opportunity to say thankyou as over the last week we have noticed a decline in this.
