

Ratiobow Award Certificates

It is always a pleasure to see so many children coming to the office for their Rainbow Award Certificates. From Reception, each class has an eight-step chart to celebrate children meeting behaviour expectations. At the end of the eight steps, children are awarded a certificate, one for each colour of the rainbow. Once the child reaches their blue certificate, they are also awarded a book along with their certificate which we aim to present during a school assembly. Certificates are alternately awarded by class teacher and head teacher.

Reading—Books Not Returned

As a school we want to promote the love of reading, not only at school but at home also and have invested heavily in buying new books for this purpose. Since February, we have been sending home reading books for your child to share with you in the comfort of your own home. We asked that children keep their book in their book bag, along with their busy book, and bring it into school every day so that we can also read it with them in school. The books

To ensure that we have always got a sufficient number of books available throughout school to allow a book to be sent home with every child, we advised in the class newsletter sent out on 23rd February 2024, that if the book was not returned there would be a small charge of £3 to go towards replacing the book which will be payable through our ParentMail +Pay system.

Uniform

Whilst we don't have a strict uniform policy in school, we know that all children wearing a school uniform leads to a greater feeling of unity and community, which are important for good behaviour and positive attitudes to learning. Over recent weeks, we have seen a number of non-uniform items appearing in some classrooms. I would like to remind parents that we ask that children wear the following items

- * jade green sweatshirt or cardigan
- * white shirt or polo shirt
- grey skirt, dress or trousers, or a green gingham summer dress where appropriate
- * black school shoes or plain black trainers with plain socks

Pickering Castle Pass

Pickering castle on Castlegate is managed by English Heritage and is open to visitors from April to October. Residents of Pickering can obtain a pass which gives them free entry into the castle. The pass is available from the town council office between 9 am and 12 noon, Monday to Friday. Residents will need to bring an official document showing address, a passport sized photograph which can be attached to the pass and £1.00 to cover the administration cost. The pass is valid whilst the holder is a resident of Pickering.
