Pupil Premium

School may be entitled to additional 'Pupil Premium Funding' if parents are in receipt of Income Support; Income Based Job Seekers Allowance, etc. Applying is easy to do and your child will receive free milk daily in school from Year One onwards and three free school jumpers each year. It may also mean that you get subsidised, free access to school visits and even free access to FEAST for free holiday activities with meals (Further details available at <https://northyorkshiretogether.co.uk/feast/>). If you are in receipt of these benefits/credits (even temporarily) would

you please contact the school office and complete the form to check eligibility.
